IMPORTANT NOTICE- NATIVITY CHURCH Dear Parishioners.

As announced at Mass on Sunday 26th November, on-going work on the installation of a replacement boiler in Nativity Church continues. It is hoped that the work will not be unduly delayed.

As announced at Mass, from 27th November onwards, all liturgies normally celebrated in Nativity Church will be translated to St Luke's Church, Twinbrook in the interim. Therefore:

> Sunday Mass at 10am Thursday Mass at 10am **Baptisms and Funerals** will take place in St Luke's Church.

Why is this necessary? It is unfair to expect parishioners to sit in an unheated church. I wish to emphasise that the translation to St Luke's is simply a temporary measure until such times as the new boiler is installed in Nativity Church. I will endeavour to keep you updated regarding the timeframe for the return of celebrations in Nativity Church. I trust that you recognise the necessity for this temporary translation,

and I wish to thank you for your understanding. I look forward to the resumption of celebrations in Nativity Church in the coming weeks.
