

CONTACTING YOUR PRIESTS

Since Fr Aidan's departure from Nativity Parish, Fathers Brian, Colin and Rory have assumed responsibility for responding to emergency sick calls. Emergency sick calls are those necessitating the presence of a priest to celebrate the Sacrament of the Sick, which often includes absolution and the administering of the Viaticum, (the Eucharist) to those who are seriously ill and approaching death. In addition, the ministry of priests often involves responding to the death of a parishioner, offering prayers for the deceased, in addition to providing consolation to the families concerned. In addition, due to the complexities and dangers connected with on-going Covid-19 pandemic, priests must exercise caution at this time when responding to such situations, to protect their own health and the health of their parishioners
